Exhibition (Main): (Maximum team size: 5 students, Minimum: 1)
National=\$50/team/entry, Local=\$25/team/entry (2 team max per school)

Game (Main): (Maximum team size: 5 students, Minimum: 2)
National=\$50/team/entry, Local=\$25/team/entry (2 team max per school)

Bottle SumoBot (Open): (Maximum team size: 3 students, Minimum: 2)
National=\$50/team/entry, Local=\$25/team/entry (2 team max per school)

RoboParade (Open): (Maximum team size: 5 students, Minimum: 2)
National=\$30/team/entry, Local=\$20/team/entry (40 floats max for this category; entries accepted on first-come-first-served based on date of full payment received by HI FusionED)

Registration closes February 23th, 2018

All payments must be received before deadline to be eligible for Regional Qualifying Tournament

Volunteer Requirements: 2 volunteer per school

All participating schools are required to provide at least 2 volunteers PER SCHOOL (*not* per team) for the Hawai'i Regional Tournament.

Volunteers must be registered on the volunteer website by March 9th, 2018.
Note: This will require some coordination between school team leaders. Plan early and accordingly to avoid school disqualification.

ROBOFEST TEAM REGISTRATION & ON-LINE POSTING PROCESS

In addition to local registration, all Hawai'i Robofest coaches are required to post their teams (including all individual student names) and volunteers (2 volunteers per school who are NOT coaches or assistant coaches) no later than March 9th, 2018. No exceptions. School teams will be disqualified if posting and volunteer requirements are not met.

Please note that the registration site for Hawai'i will close on February 23rd, 2017, *without exception*. Only teams who have submitted actual student names (in other words, real names and not representations like "Student 1, Student 2, etc.") and volunteers on the site will be eligible to participate in the Hawai'i Regional Tournament on April 7th, 2018, at Pearl City High School.

REGISTRATION REQUIRES BOTH STEPS TO BE COMPLETED:

STEP I: PAYMENT (Local) – EMAIL following information to HI FusionED (info@hifusioned.org)

- School name and mailing address
- Total Number of Teams
- Activity Category for Each Team
 - Activity Categories are: Exhibition, Robot Game, Bottle SumoBot or RoboParade
- Identify what division (Junior: grades 5-8 or Senior: grades 9-12)*
- **All payments (see Page 1 for fees) should be made payable to:**
 - **HI FusionED**
 - **Mail to: P.O. Box 10653, Honolulu, Hawai'i 96816**
 - If your school requires an invoice generated by HI FusionED, please provide the name of your SASA or Point of Contact and his/her active email address (HI FusionED will provide digital copies only). All payments (even for Purchase Orders) must be received by February 23rd, 2018.

STEP II: POSTING (National) – www.robofest.net (and click on 2018 link)

- Log in as New Coach Registration (or, if you participated last year, use Coach Login; you can use last year's CoachID and password) and follow prompts (HI FusionED does not have access to passwords.)
- If a payment option is prompted, just select "Pay by Check" option and ***DO NOT PAY ONLINE***. HI FusionED will collect all Hawaii payments and forward total to LTU. All checks should be sent/mailed to HI FusionED (see mailing address above).
- Posting of Teams (including Team Name/ID No., First/Last name of each team members, team photo) should be posted by February 23rd, 2018, to avoid Regional disqualification.

*If any of your students need Age Waivers, you must get approval directly from LTU (Dr. CJ Chung) at least 21 days prior to the Regional Qualifier. RoboParade accepts students from Grade 3 and up, waivers not required. Age Waiver forms are downloadable from the www.robofest.net website. Copy or final approval from Dr. Chung should be emailed to HI FusionED at info@hifusioned.org.
